## Jonathan Wateridge joins GRIMM

## Announcing the representation of Jonathan Wateridge in London and Amsterdam

GRIMM is proud to announce the representation of UK-based painter Jonathan Wateridge. The artist's first solo show with the gallery is scheduled in early 2025 in London.

Jonathan Wateridge's work has been the subject of a courageous reinvention that started about five years ago. A sense of freedom and rebirth permeates his new paintings, which depict figures suspended between perceived reality and imagination. By leaving photographic realism behind, he has opened his practice to the endless possibilities provided by what paint as a medium is capable of. Figures rise to the surface, often in ghostly forms. Texture and physical detail become the focus of the work. While each depiction appears to be naturalistic at first, on close inspection the subject dissolves into pure matter.

In these new works, as opposed to his earlier realist paintings, paint is not used to heighten realism but to disrupt it.

"It is a constant battle to find the balance between an exploratory improvisational approach to the making of the painting and the sense of a fully realised psychological and narrative space. The line between failure and success is very narrow but that is exactly what makes it exciting." - Jonathan Wateridge

GRIMM will include new paintings by Wateridge as part of its Frieze London 2024 presentation, followed by a solo exhibition at the gallery's London location in early 2025.

"I'm thrilled and honoured to be joining GRIMM's highly impressive roster of artists - some whose work I've known and admired for over two decades and other formidable younger talents that have come to the fore in recent years.
